Course Format

Training is instructor led multi-media presentation incorporating instructor lecture, group discussion and hands on break-out sessions. Learners will use a workbook that contains hard copy of presentation, forms and tools that they can apply in your workplace. They will also have access to the WORCS Website library of useful tools.

Upon successful completion of this course, learners will receive a certificate signed by the WORCS instructor and an OSHA 10-Hour card issued by OSHA.
